Money buys another animal, profits banked for future education funding. “Not to just give money, they get lazy” says Wayan concerned about losing traditional Balinese skills. “With a pig, young girls learn domestic responsibility – cooking with edible plants grown in community land, left-over use. Young boys learn rice field management – planting crops, growing edible grasses”.
